Saturday: Practices


Mixed weather conditions made tyre choice difficult throughout the day, but we still managed plenty of laps and **showed encouraging pace** heading into qualifying.

Qualifying: **P5**


A late **switch to wets proved to be the right call** as the rain intensified. Traffic limited me to one clean flying lap, but fortunately it came at the ideal moment before conditions worsened, securing P5.

Sunday: Heat: P5  P22

After a good start, I was caught in an early incident that dropped me to the back and damaged the steering. Despite the issues, **I nursed the kart home** to the finish to salvage what points I could.

Pre-Final: P22  P11

A solid recovery drive through the field. I made steady progress, although being stuck behind groups of karts at times prevented an even stronger result.

Final: P13  P6

A strong opening stint helped me climb quickly through the order, but the leaders had already broken clear, leaving me unable to **bridge the gap and challenge further**.
